This book addresses the emotions of a child living with the absence of a father.

While using genuine dialogues that strongly contain the element of childhood naivety, the author sets up a story in which the main hero stands negatively and against his new 'father'.

The child's reaction is the result of his fears about who his mother loves more and, the fact that he believes that this man does not love him. This continues up until an incident convinces him of the opposite. It is a naturally written story without exaggerations on the part of the author that can help readers with similar experiences see things in a deeper perspective.
